Special Presentation.

The Brown Water Navy in Vietnam

The members of the Freedom Committee of Orange County were honored with a presentation on a war that most of us were unaware of. **CDR Kirk Ferguson**

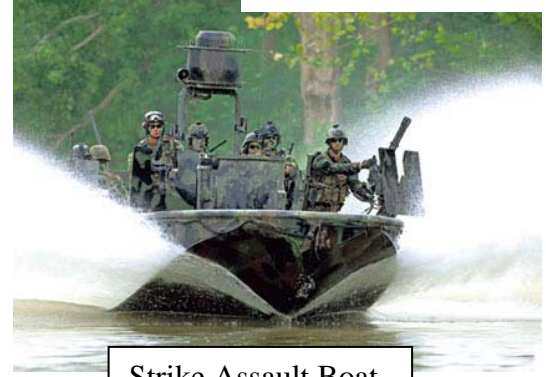


experienced the Mekong Delta war in South Vietnam that was fought not by the Navy of huge aircraft carriers on Yankee Station in the blue waters of the South China Sea. This war fought by the Brown Water Navy, named for the muddy hue of the water in the many rivers, canals and

waterways in the Mekong Delta of South Vietnam. Vice Admiral Elmo Zumwalt, Commander of Naval Forces in Vietnam and later Chief of Naval Operations implemented a strategy called SEALORDS. This Strategy called for a blockade barrier against the Viet Cong and North Vietnamese infiltration across the Cambodian border. The Viet Cong were being supplied an estimated 175 to 200 tons per month

using small sampans. CDR Ferguson commanded STABRON 20 which consisted of 20 Strike Assault Boats (STABs). These low silhouettes, 27 ft length, aluminum hulls were double walls with flotation foam between and were virtually unsinkable. They were powered by twin Chevrolet 350 hp gas engines with a top speed of 55 knots and manned with a crew of 3 + 6 SEALs and 5 machine guns. A typical sailor took part in 172 ambushes during his one year tour in Vietnam. In one of the most

successful operations, Giant Slingshot, which attempted to isolate the Parrot's Beak section of Cambodia, total seizures of 150 tons of ammunition and 400 tons supplies headed to South Vietnam in a 5 month period in 1970. The Mekong Delta is the bread basket of Southeast Asia. The source of the water begins high in the Himalayan Mountains of India and flows down the Mekong River, the 10th longest river in the world at 3,050 miles. At the Vietnam border the Mekong River divides into 9 channels. The extreme seasonal variations in flow and water level caused navigation problems. The Vietnamese grow rice when the river floods and fruit in the dry season.

In December 1970, STABRON20 stood down in the process of Vietnamization leaving the water war to the Vietnamese. The Navy Unit Commendation Medal was awarded to them.
