Remembrance Day: Chairman Jack Hammett

Jack Hammett set the theme for today, 9/11, a Special Day to remember the attack on the USA. Only three times in history has the USA homeland been attacked: The War of 1812 when Britain attacked the USA; 1941 Pearl Harbor when Japan attacked the USA; and 9/11/2001 when 19 Islamic terrorist attacked the USA. Jack's daughter volunteered with the Salvation Army at Ground Zero that day and brought vivid memories home of that destruction. So we remember those 2,998 mostly civilians that lost their lives 12 years ago.

George Emerson

SPECIAL PRESENTATION

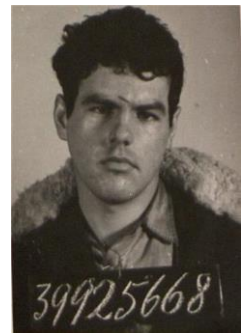
Sgt George Emerson was **tail gunner**, one of nine crewmen on a WWII B-17 bomber who defended against enemy fighter attacks from the rear of the plane. The tail gunner operated a machine gun on the tail-end of the aircraft with an unobstructed view toward the rear. He saw the group of plane formations and the results of the bombing.

Tail gunners had a rough existence. Their compartment in the rear of the plane was one of the tightest. The gunner sat on a modified bicycle type seat in a kneeling position for the majority of the mission. The tail was drafty and the gunner had to constantly battle with fighting off frostbite and clearing the windows of frost.

On February 9, 1945, George's B-17 was part the 303rd Bomb Group, 8th Air Force, on a mission to bomb a synthetic oil refinery in Lutzendorf, Germany when they came under anti-aircraft fire. A plane near Emerson's was hit by anti-aircraft flak, lost control, and collided with his bomber. The tail section, with Emerson still inside and unconscious, was severed from the rest of the aircraft and tumbled from 25,000 ft.

Sometime during the fall, he was flung from the tail. He estimates he must have been at around 10,000 feet when he regained consciousness and somehow, his parachute opened. He landed in a field, and except for a gash on his head, he was fine, but very scared. The rest of the crew was killed, as was the crew of the colliding B-17.

When he landed, he was found by German farmers calling him "*Chicago Gangster*". He was taken to a German military prison near Moosberg, photographed, and remained there until liberation on April 29, 1945. The Germans wrongly wrote on his photo his last three number of his serial 668 instead of 686 that meant he was listed as missing in action instead of a POW.

ADMINISTRATION

Bette Bell, FCOC treasurer, reported on FCOC financial. Starting Balance was \$2,376.69. Expenses were \$604.28 and donations were \$433.66. The ending balance was \$2,206.07. **Scott Williams** reported that the 2012 audit was completed with *no* deficiencies. Bette received a big round of applause: **Job WELL done, Bette!**

Scott Williams stated that FCOC has entered into a contract with the Newport/Mesa Union School District to bring “*The FCOC Living History Program*” into their six high schools. FCOC has entered into an agreement with **Denise Weiland**, as an independent contractor, to administer this program. She has conducted a similar living history program which has worked so well at Corona del Mar High School for the past several years.
